School Report – Rita	<p>Current school enrollment 168 for 2014-2015            8 in Montessori, 8 in pre-K, 18 in K, 20 in 1<sup>st</sup>, 17 in 2<sup>nd</sup>, 23 in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 15 in 4<sup>th</sup>, 22 in 5<sup>th</sup>, 16 in 6<sup>th</sup>, 14 in 7<sup>th</sup>, 7 in 8<sup>th</sup></p> <p>The school was approved for Ohio’s Education Choice Expansion Program and has a few families approved for the coming school year. This program will be available as long as funding is available.</p> <p>We will offer two languages this year- Spanish and Sign Language. Monica Carhuay will be the new Spanish teacher.</p> <p>A new 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teacher has been hired. Peggy Posendek is a recent Marietta College graduate and salutatorian of her class.</p> <p>We are in need of an Intervention specialist. Our current specialist left this week to accept a full time job with Marietta schools. Mrs. Angel has contacted the city schools to post the position and request at least a sub to start the school year.</p> <p>Monday, August 18 is an information and introduction session for Montessori, pre-K and kindergarten parents.</p> <p>Tuesday, August 19 is the School grounds Clean Up at 6 pm. Any help is appreciated.</p>	
3. Boosters -	<p>No report.</p> <p>Mrs. Angel stated Vince Stollar is the new president.</p> <p>As nonprofits the boosters and Home and School need to register with the Attorney General’s office. The 2 groups are working together to register as one group.</p>

This is a drop in program paid in ½ hour increments. (\$8.00/ ½ hour).</p>
