2. School Report – Rita	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. St. Mary is now designated as an Ed Choice school in Ohio. Federal grant (tuition money) is available through Ed Choice Expansion. This is available for <u>NEW</u> kindergarten and first grade students for the 2014-2015 school year. It is income-based. Qualifying families can make no more than 200% of the federal poverty level. Scholarship will pay full tuition for parishioners. For non-parishioners, it will pay \$4,250 for the 2014-2015 school year. 2. 8th graders taking algebra one will continue to receive the high school credit. New for the 2014-2015 school year, 9th grade English will be offered at St. Mary as a high school credit. 3. Enrollment – currently 110. 4. End of year activities are commencing. 5. Paula Sewell and Cathy Dunaway are planning after school tutoring four days per week (Monday through Thursday). Maximum two hours (3:30 to 5:30). There will be a fee (\$8 per half hour). Summer tutoring will also be available (mornings). Information is forthcoming. Available only to St. Mary students.
