The SMS Foundation is a nonprofit charitable organization established to support, strengthen, and sustain the educational mission of St. Mary's School. Its purpose is to meet the challenges of Catholic education today

and tomorrow by protecting the long-term financial stability of our school for generations to come.

While annual tuition and limited diocesan funding cover basic day-to-day expenses—such as teacher salaries and utilities—they do not account for major or unexpected needs. When a roof leaks, 30+ year-old flooring needs replaced, or additional safety and security measures are required to protect our children; that is where the Foundation steps in.

The Foundation hosts one fundraiser each year: our Annual Benefit Drawing on Saturday, February 7. Tickets are \$150 and admit two guests.


