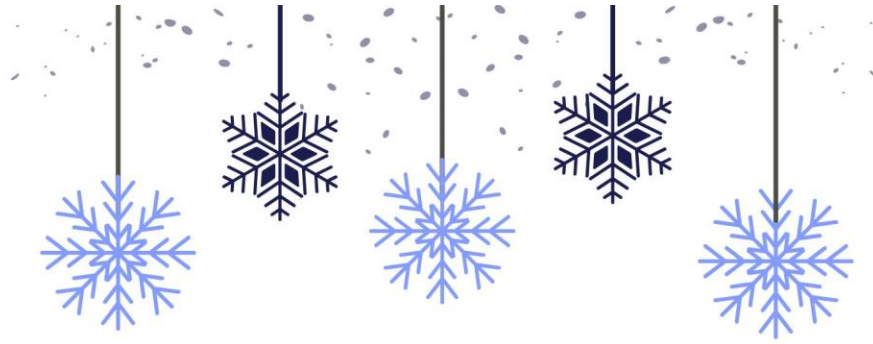
Welcome to 2026! It is hard to believe that we are almost halfway through this school year! The 2nd quarter ends on Friday, January 16th.

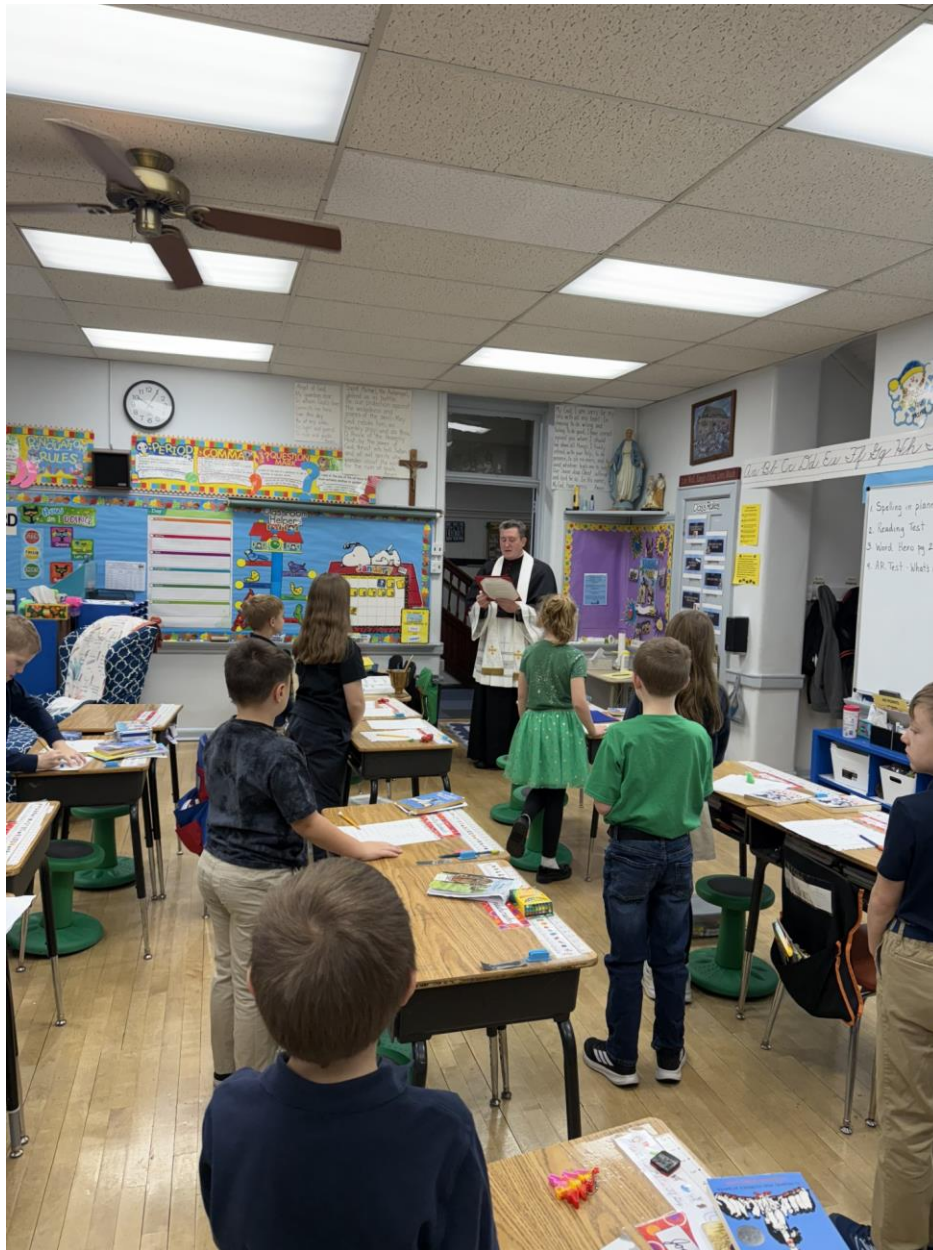
Catholic Schools week will be at the end of January. Be on the lookout for the fun things St. Mary's will be doing that week.
