
Welcome to 2026! It is hard to believe that we are almost halfway through this school year! The 2nd quarter ends on Friday, January 16<sup>th</sup>.


**Catholic Schools week will be at the end of January. Be on the lookout for the fun things St. Mary's will be doing that week.**
