



#### **3v3 BASKETBALL RULES**

#### **Rules and Regulations**

- The following rules have been designed to ensure fair play for all participants. Each player is expected to understand these rules prior to participation in the tournament.
  - Any question concerning these rules should be directed to the event staff.

#### **Prior to the Game**

- Each team must have a minimum of 3 players and a maximum of 4 on its roster. The roster may be co-ed or teams may be male or female.
- The names of these players must be on the registration form by the entry deadline. These players must be 18 years or older at the time of registration.
  - Additions and/or changes to any roster must be approved by tournament officials and completed prior to the start of the team's first game.
    - No roster changes are allowed once a team has started their first game. A player is allowed to participate for only one team for the duration of the tournament.

- All players must sign the score sheet before each game and designate the team's captain/spokesperson.
  - O The team captain will always represent his/her team as a spokesperson.
- All games must start with three players on each team, unless a team with three players agrees to allow the opposing team to play with only two players. The game will be forfeited if a team doesn't show up after 5 minutes.
- A coin flip or rock/paper/scissors prior to the start of the game will determine which team
   has the initial possession.

#### Starting Play/Throw-In

- The ball must be checked and thrown (not dribbled) behind the top of the arc of the three
  point line.
  - O First Violation: Warning from the referee or court monitor
    - O Subsequent Violations: Change of Possession

#### **Game Play**

- Length of Games: 12 Minute running clock. If a game is tied at the end of game play for round robin play, the tie will stand.
  - If the game is tied for an elimination game, an overtime will be played.
  - Overtime will be 2 minutes in length. If still tied after the first overtime, a 2nd overtime will be played with the first team to score 4 points or more (ex. Team makes a two pointer and a three pointer = five points) wins the game.
  - No make it or take it. The ball changes possession after each basket scored.
    - Jump Balls: All jump balls become the possession of the defensive team.
- Time Outs: Each team is allowed one 30-second timeout per game. The running game clock does not stop during any timeouts. No timeouts are permitted in the last three minutes of the game.
- Ball Clearance: When in play, the ball must be "cleared" on each change of possession.
   "Cleared" means both feet must be behind the three-point arc. Failure to clear the basketball is a violation.
  - O First Violation is a warning from the court monitor.

- O Subsequent Violations will result in a change of possession.
- No Parking Zone: There is no 3 second rule, per se. However, the expectation is that players do not park in the key. Therefore, a 5 second rule where a player may not be in the key.
  - O First Violation is a warning from the court monitor
  - O Subsequent Violations will result in a change of possession.
- Scoring: Baskets made from inside the arc count as two points. Baskets made when the shooter has both feet behind the arc count as three points. Court monitors or referees will call "two points." If there is any doubt on the location of the shot, 2 points will be given by the court monitor. NO DUNKING IS PERMITTED.
- Fouls: A court monitor/referee will oversee the game. Court monitor or referee may only call a foul. If a foul is called, the ball will be taken out above the top of the three-point line.
  - After the Game: The captain of both teams needs to sign the scoresheet to ensure the correct score is reported. If there is a discrepancy, the decision of the scorekeeper will be final.
    - ◆ Tournament Scoring: For bracket play; Win = 3 points, Loss = 0 points, Tie = 1 point
       Tie breaking procedures (at end of round-robin play)
      - 1st most points (using win-loss-tie format)
        - 2nd Head-to-Head
      - 3rd Point differential (Points for Points against)
        - 4th Points against
          - 5th Points for
        - 6th Free throw (shooting, 1 player per team.)
      - O Decisions for any issues will be made by the tournament director and will be final.

#### Waiver of Liability for 3v3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Waiver: In consideration of being permitted to participate in the "Luck of the Irish" 3v3 Basketball Tournament, I, for myself, my heirs, personal representative or assigns, do hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue neither St. Mary Catholic School, nor St. Mary Athletic Boosters, its officers, employees and agents from liability from all claims resulting in personal injury, accidents, or illnesses (including death), and property loss arising from, but not limited to, my participation in the "Luck of the Irish" 3v3 Basketball Tournament except as caused by their intentional, willful or wanton conduct.

Assumption of Risk: I acknowledge that my participation in the "Luck of the Irish" 3v3 Basketball Tournament is voluntary and carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries. The specific risks vary from one activity to another. Risks range from:

1) minor injuries such as scratches, bruises, and sprains to 2) major injuries such as eye injury or loss of sight, joint, or back injuries, broken bones, heart attacks and concussions to 3) catastrophic injuries including paralysis and death.

Acknowledgement of Understanding: I have read this waiver of liability, and assumption of risk. I acknowledge that I am signing the agreement freely and voluntarily and intend by my signature the agreement of liability. \*\*YOU MUST BE 18 YEARS OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION TO PLAY\*\*
