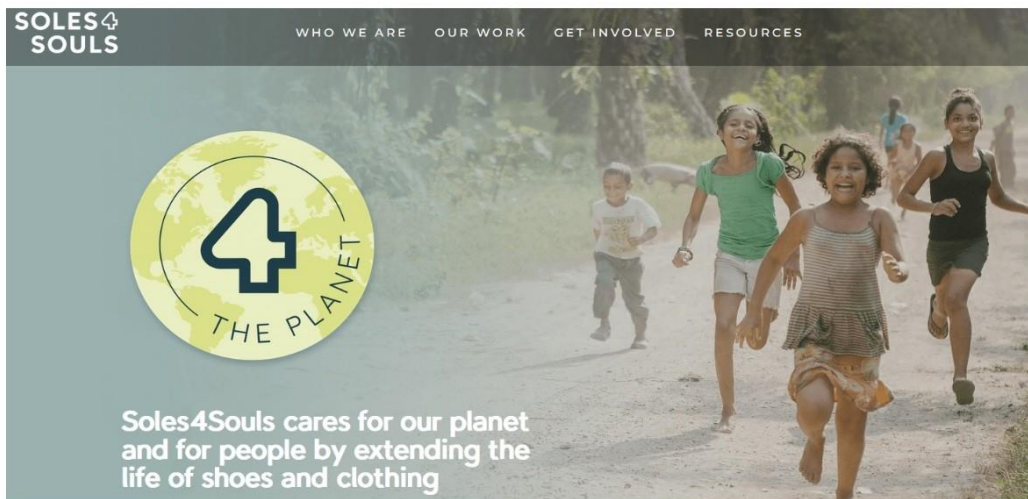
We are still selling bricks for the Path of Faith in our school parking lot. See the flyer to order a great graduation gift, fun family item or even a brick in memory or honor of someone!
