

Today we celebrated Roy Sees of Belpre, Ohio. He turns 106 years old. He is a hero of World War II who received the Bronze Medal for Heroism, wounded in combat received the Purple Heart, and is a Combat Infantryman Badge recipient.

St. Mary Catholic was represented by Flite Freimann who he taught in his History Class who Roy Sees is and the significance of his service.
