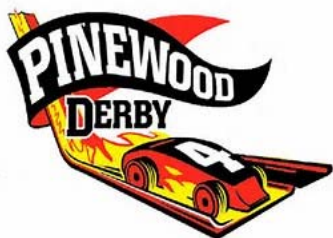
P653 Pinewood Derby Date and Time TBD

Free Pack Activities will include:

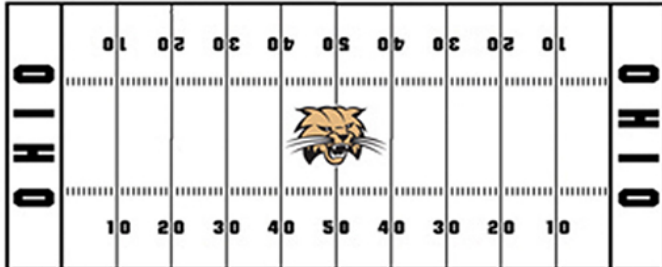
- Cooking over the campfire

Directions to Visitor Center

- From I-77 take WV exit #185; follow WV-14 (Highland Ave.) 1.3 miles; turn right onto Waverly Road (E. 4th St.); continue 2 miles to site.
- From Marietta, OH cross Williamstown Bridge, take first left after DaVinci's Restaurant onto Waverly Road (E. 4th St.); continue 2 miles to site.
- From Vienna, WV take WV-14 N to Williamstown, turn right onto Highland Ave; take first left onto Waverly Road (E. 4th St.); continue 2 miles to site.

Activities will include:

- Bird watching (binoculars available)
- Freshwater Mussels matching game
- Junior Ranger Program - Kids ages 3 through 13 can become a Junior Ranger (and older kids are welcome to participate too!). Fun activities in the workbook can be done while exploring the refuge. Participants receive a completion certificate and a badge upon completion.
- Exploring the Exhibits/Aquariums - The Visitor Center has many educational exhibits including a 1,200 gallon fish tank, which contains a mix of species from the Ohio River. They also have two turtle tanks featuring a Musk Turtle and Eastern Spiny Soft Shell Turtle.

Type of Camp: This is a family camp with all the fixin's
provided. Sign up the whole family for a boot scootin' good
time!

Check-In at Campsites: Friday evening (5 - 8 PM) Each campsite has a shelter with picnic tables where meals can be prepared. Potable water is available in each site, electricity is NOT available.

Chapel Service: Sunday morning at 9:00 AM will be chapel service at the basketball court. G-Force Strength Unit will be presenting the service. A collection will be taken to help their ministry. Check-out is 10 AM Sunday.

What to bring? Health forms (for each person attending), water proof tent, ground cloth, camp pad or air mattress, sleeping bag, extra blanket, pillow, walking shoes (NO OPEN TOE), extra shoes, rain gear, 3 pair of socks (plus EXTRA dry socks to sleep in), Class A Uniform, Hat, Extra Clothes, Jacket, Sweat Shirt, Toothbrush and Toothpaste, Brush/Comb, Wash Cloth & Towel, Soap and Shampoo, Flashlight, Extra Batteries, Bug Repellent, Water bottle, Spending money for trading post, camera (optional), alarm clock, first aid kit, snacks to share over campfire, lantern, cooler with ice.

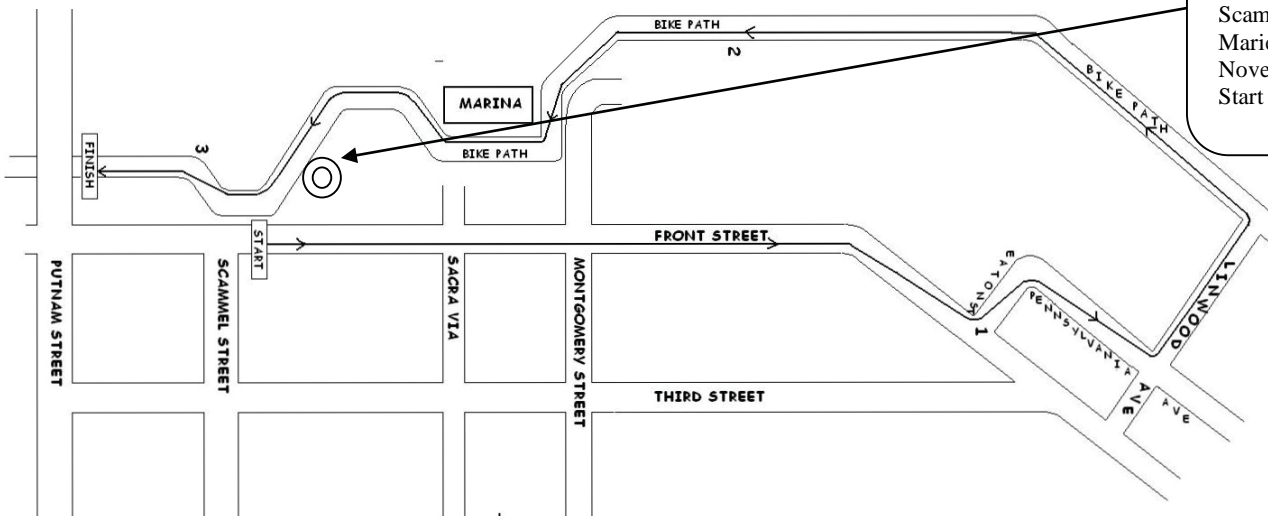
