Turn everyday shopping into fundraising dollars. For every gift card purchased, a percentage of that card is given back to you and to the school. For example: Purchase a Southwest Airline gift certificate for \$500 (4% earnings: split between you and school) This means you buy the card at face value, yet 2% of that money comes back to the school and 2% goes directly towards tuition reimbursement for your family.

If the roughly 1000 families of the basilica parish made use of this program to its fullest, we could collectively raise over \$1,000,000 for the school a year without any fundraising!
