The Marietta Soccer League is open to children ages 4-15 to participate in recreational soccer.

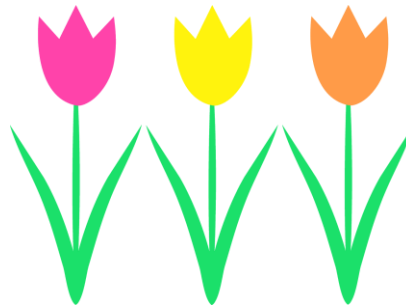
