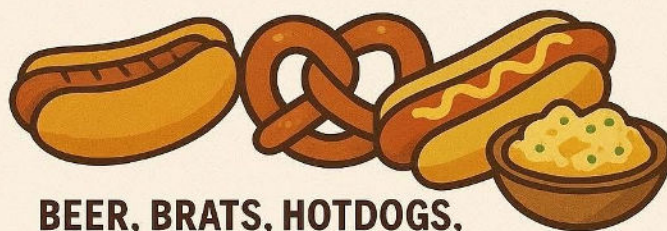

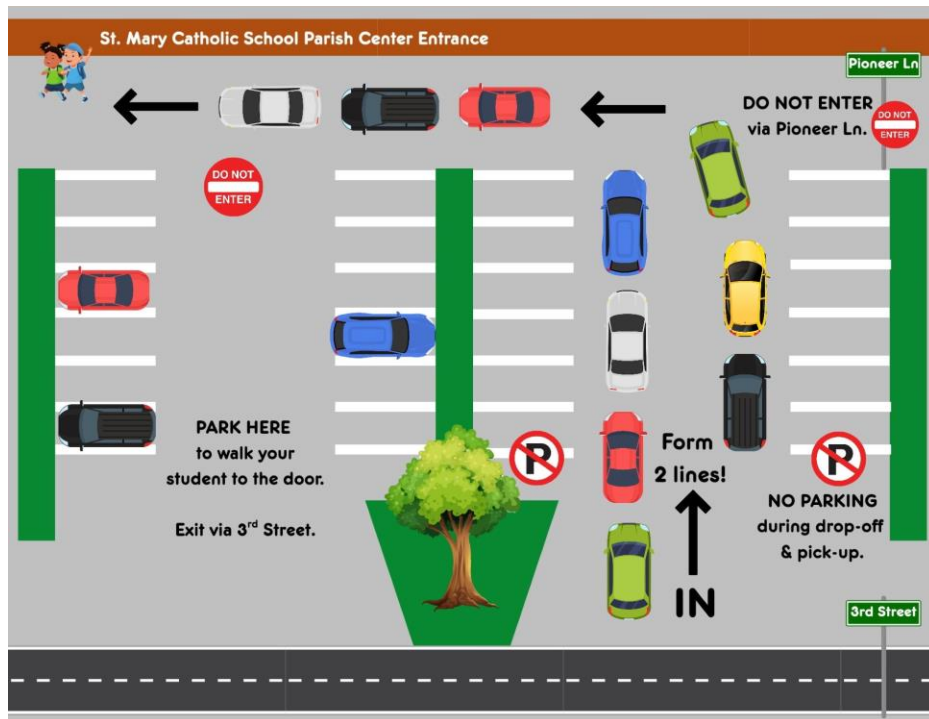

car line. Need a sign for pick up?

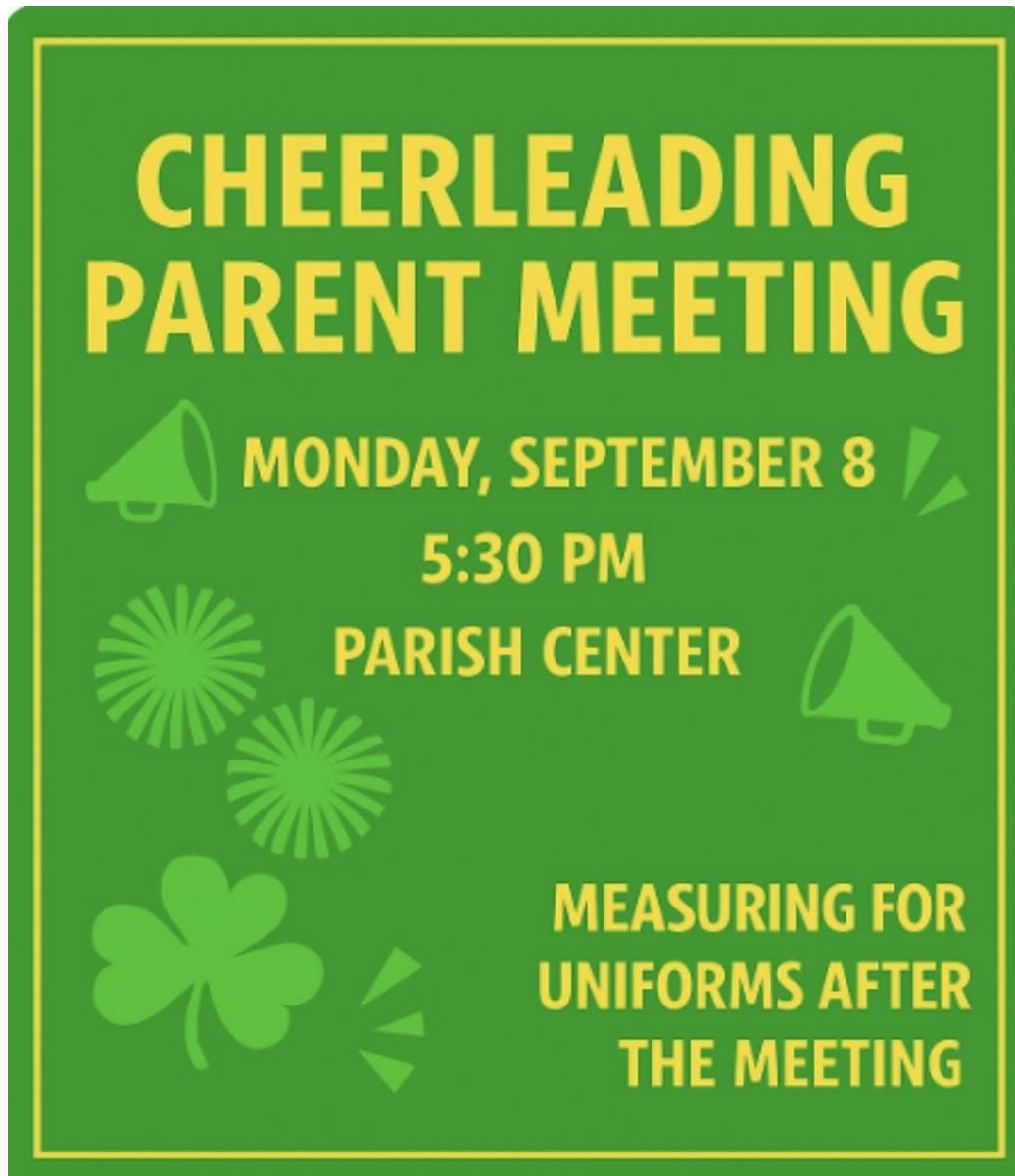
